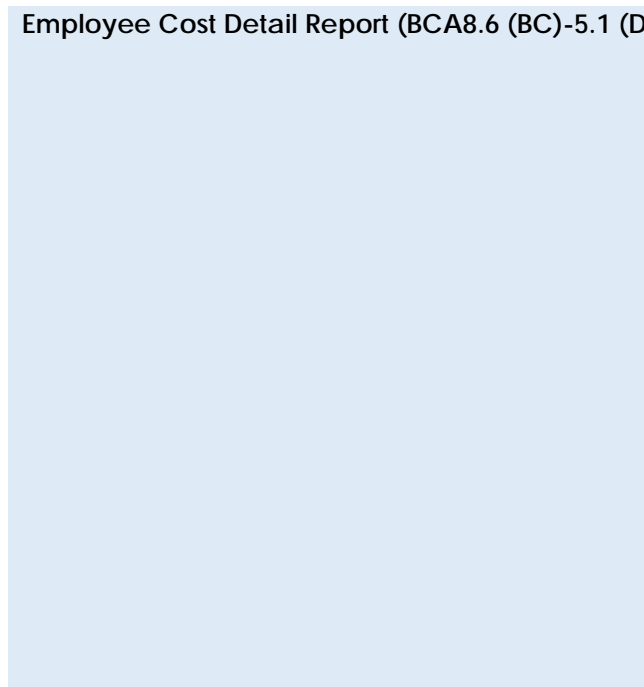

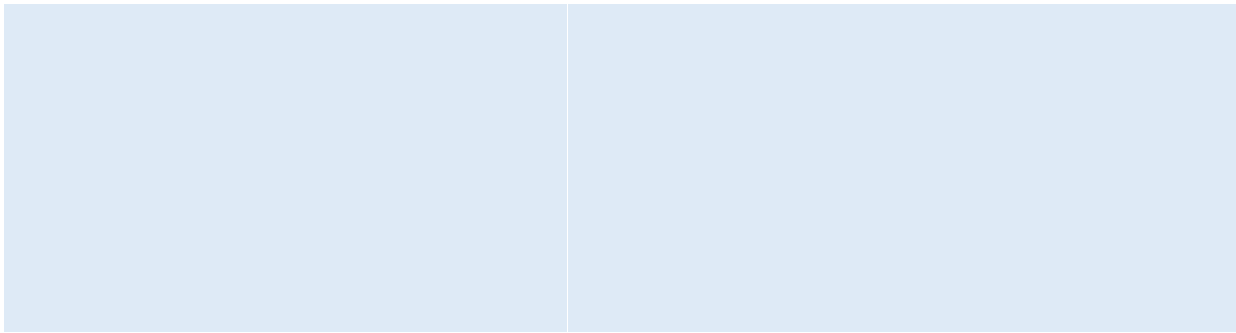

<p>Automated Adjustments Online Page – Enhancements</p>	<p>Navigation: Menu > Payroll for North America > Payroll Customization > Automated Adjustments</p> <p>Issue: Separate Check # field is not in a central location on the automated adjustments page.</p> <p>Solution: Move the field to a newly created section named Separate Check Option.</p> <p>Issue: Transactions with an inactive combination code can be saved; no warning message is produced.</p> <p>Solution: Create hard stop message “ Account code invalid” that prevents page from being saved.</p>

<p>Automated Adjustments – Earnings Adjustment Load Enhancement</p>	<p>Navigation: Menu > Payroll for North America > Payroll Customization > Automated Adjustments</p> <p>Issue: There is no logic on the earnings adjustment spreadsheet load to prevent a transaction for an employee’s former paygroup from loading.</p> <p>Solution: Enhance the Earnings Adjustment Load logic. Create a new message “Empl Record does not match Job Data” when this scenario is identified.</p>
<p>Manage SSCP Contribution – Enhancement for SSC Support Users</p>	<p>Navigation: Menu > BOR Customizations > SSCP Contributions > Manage SSP Contribution</p> <p>Issue: SSC Support Users cannot change the pay rate for this scenario.</p>
