White/non-Hispanic student enrollment decreased by 3.3 percent (4,884 students).
 White/non-Hispanic students represent 46.0 percent of all students, compared to 47.2 percent in Spring 2021.

In-state enrollment as a share of overall enrollment declined from **8**1.7 percent in Spring 2021 to 80.0 in Spring 2022. The share of out-of-state students increased from 12.1 percent to 13.0 percent. The percentage of out-of-state students with tuition waived declined from 35.1 percent to 33.9 percent. The share of out-of-country enrollees increased from 6.2 percent to 7.0 percent and the percentage with tuition waived decreased from 36.4 percent to 36.2 percent.

Female student enrollment (178,034) continues to be substantially higher than male student enrollment (136,2840912 0 612 792 re95F3 1 00.00000912 0 612Tf 0 Gm 12 Tk8 Tm8(up 0 G5/F3 12 Tf)
