Applicants must be the following minimum criteria:

- 1. U.S. citizen at least 18 years of age.
- 2. In good academic standing.
- 3. Must be enrolled in school during the semester the student plans to intern.
- 4. Recommended by their college or university to participate in the program.
- 5. Have met or be willing to meet the requirements for internships for their respective institutions.

Program Requirements

Program is open to full--time students pursuing an undergraduate or graduate degree at an accredited college or university in business administration, criminal justice, political science, public administration, conflict resolution, or related field of study.

Students must be juniors or seniors in undergraduate school or first year graduate students in order to participate in the program.
