

Academic Advisory Committee on Psychology Bylaws

Article I: Membership

The membership of the Academic Advisory Committee on Psychology will be composed of one voting member from each institution within the University System of Georgia. That member will be the head of the unit in which psychology is housed or his or her designee. When there is more than one unit head representing psychology at a given institution, the president of that institution shall designate one unit head as the official representative of the institution.

Article II:

The term of office for each member of the Executive Committee shall begin on July 1 and end on June 30 of the following year. The Executive Committee shall represent the membership of the Academic Advisory Committee on Psychology and act for the Academic Advisory Committee when the Committee is not in session. The Executive Committee shall make all reasonable attempts to communicate with and solicit opinions from the membership of the Advisory Committee prior to exercising authority under this article.

The Chair-Elect will arrange for hosting the annual meeting. The Chair will develop the agenda for the annual meeting. The Past Chair will keep and distribute minutes of the annual meeting.
