## Follow-up on FLAAC's previous questions:

- 1. Many students minor in FL. How can the data be displayed to BOR? USG does not collect minor data. Data governance teams have discussed this in the past with no resolution. Data may be collected at the institutional level. Difficulty moving students through a 4-semester sequence. Minor a better option, but this will need to be tracked at the institutional level. Can be annotated and tracked in Banner at the institutional level.
- 2. Questions about American Studies minor from Lisa. FL creates challenges for other majors because of the necessary sequencing of FL courses.
- 3. FL courses are available all year long and can be completed off the normal Fall/Spring cycle. Advisors need to promote FL study early on.

- 5. Problems with counting 1001 & 1002 in Core. If a Major requires FL 2001 and 2002 in Area F, they must also allow for 1001 and 1002.
